Pastor's Report to Council—August 2025

As always, please feel free to let me know if you need additional or different material shared in the Pastor's Report.

Worship and Music

- <u>Blessing of the Backpacks Aug. 17</u>—We'll have a chance to have a moment on Aug. 17 to ask God's blessing on our students and teachers, and to give a special gift symbolizing God's presence throughout the school year to them as well.
- <u>Blue Jean Sunday Outdoor Service Sept. 7</u>—Our outdoor service will feature our "house band" (CoC members, along with Eric) at 9:00am, much as we did last year.
- Return to Two Services Sept. 14—We'll return to our usual two services at 8:00am and 10:00am on Sunday Sept. 14, with the Sunday School hour in between services.
- <u>Funerals Since June Council Meeting</u>—Since our last meeting, we hosted the funeral service for Susie Donnal and Lois Wise, and Vicar Natalie and I were also both asked to help with an off-site committal service for the brother of Natalie Rilling, in Elmore, Ohio.
- <u>Choir Resuming for Fall</u>—Lisa Alleman will return this fall to conduct the choir, which will resume rehearsals on Wednesdays at 7:00pm on Sept. 10 (Wednesday after Blue Jean Sunday). Bells will resume practices on Thursdays.

Christian Education and Youth

- Bryce Hinegardner Starts as Children, Youth, and Family Facilitator—You may well have already met Bryce, but he did officially start on July 14, and currently his schedule of work days is split with Mondays and Tuesdays at Community of Christ, Wednesdays and Thursdays at Providence, with alternating Sundays and evening events as schedules need. We'll keep council apprised of any major changes to that routine, and we'll also anticipate that Bryce will alternate which council meetings he can attend, since Community of Christ and Providence each have their meetings on second Tuesdays.
- <u>Start of Sunday School Year</u>—We'll start with Sunday School classes on Sunday, Sept. 14; we are currently trying a new curriculum, "WonderInk," and working on supplementing the roster of teachers who are returning from last year with some new teachers to create a five-week rotation as our goal.
- <u>Start of Joint Providence-CoC Youth Group</u>—Bryce is planning to launch a regularly gathering Youth Group from Providence and Community of Christ, with a kick-off on Sunday Sept. 14 in the evening; stay tuned for more details there.
- Adult Class (Sundays)—Our summer series, "Hard Sayings of Jesus" will conclude on Aug. 17, and then we'll have two stand-alone special events on Aug. 24 and 31 (a meet-and-greet with Bryce for the congregation, and then a "Questions from A Hat" open forum with Vicar Natalie and Pastor Steve). A new series for the fall will begin Sept. 14, entitled, "Who Is My Neighbor?" featuring voices and perspectives from people in the wider community.

- <u>Anthony Wayne Area Youth Back-to-School Party</u>—Our Back-to-School party on the evening of Aug. 24 will feature food trucks, games, and water activities from 6:00-7:30pm. We will be asking participating congregations (looking at four right now) to split costs evenly.
- <u>Thursday Afternoon Bible Study</u>—Vicar Natalie and I are currently leading an original series on several of the shorter, lesser known minor prophets of the Old Testament, called "Rare Birds," this August.
- "In the Presence of God" Summer Spirituality Series: This series has been well-received so far, with a variety of topics, presenters, and experiences, and a good number of participants (probably averaging 12 a week, but sometimes as many as 25). Our final two sessions remain.
- <u>Summer Reading and Weekly Story Time</u>—We have had a good deal of positive response to this weekly time (Tuesdays at 10:00, with Vicar Natalie, Bryce, and me) with stories, songs, and activities. Sometimes we have had just two kids in attendance; other weeks more than ten, but it has always been a positive experience for the kids and families who have attended. This seems like something to continue in some form in the future.

Visitation Ministry

• <u>Into Your Hands... End of Life Workshop Reprise</u>—In July, our second offering of this workshop was held with about 15 participants. Visitation plans to have end-of-life issues be one of several rotating annual education focus themes, so we anticipate offering this workshop again in some form in another few years.

Social Action

- Follow-Up from Christian Holy Land Solidarity Cooperative (Olive Wood Handcrafts)—This event was well-received on June 22, and didn't require a great deal of work or organization on our part. We were able to confirm that this group does directly help people living in Bethlehem in the midst of war (and the hurting local economy), and people seemed pleased with the olive wood handcraft items they were able to purchase.
- Fundraising Projects for Salem Lutheran Meal Ministry and Tree-Planting—Currently we have two special projects aimed at raising funds for Salem (their weekly meal ministry and tree planting in the fall like we did last year), with the "Abundance is Meant to Be Shared" stickers and the same design in a canvas tote bag available this fall. We'll be organizing a day in October to plant trees in the arboretum Pastor Hanck is creating adjacent to the church.
- <u>"God's Work. Our Hands" Service Project for 2025—Food for Thought</u>—We'll be making sandwiches for distribution to people in downtown Toledo on the evening of Friday, Sept. 14 as this year's "God's Work. Our Hands" service project.
- <u>School Supply Kits for Lutheran World Relief</u>—We'll also be inviting the congregation once again to collect and donate items for school kits; Carrie Tuohy is confirmed to help with the collection and to take the kits to the local collection site this fall as well.

Concert Committee

• <u>July 27 Concert: "Garms Family Singers"</u>—This concert was held while I was on vacation (July 27) but I understand the music was good, but the attendance not as high as might have been expected. However, the summer scheduling (this was working with dates that were offered by this family of musicians as part of their tour) is likely to have been a factor, and that's something we should consider for future concert dates.

Stewardship Committee

• Preparations for Festival of Talents 2025—Stewardship asks all committees to have a presence at a table with some kind of display and volunteer to invite participation from members at our 2nd annual Festival of Talents on Oct. 11 (with a talent show program followed by an open house with committee displays and visual talents) and a follow-up on Sunday. Oct. 12. We'll also be preparing Time and Talent forms for 2025-2026, so we would ask if you have items you would like added, changed, or edited relating to your committee from last year's form, please let Pastor Steve know. We will do our utmost to make sure all committees are represented accurately!

Administrative Matters

• <u>Compensation Procedures for Bryce Hinegardner/Providence Lutheran</u>—Providence will be sending us monthly invoices for Bryce's compensation, and Josef is aware that we'll be able to pay monthly from those to Providence, which is taking care of the direct payments/payroll work for Bryce through their financial staff.

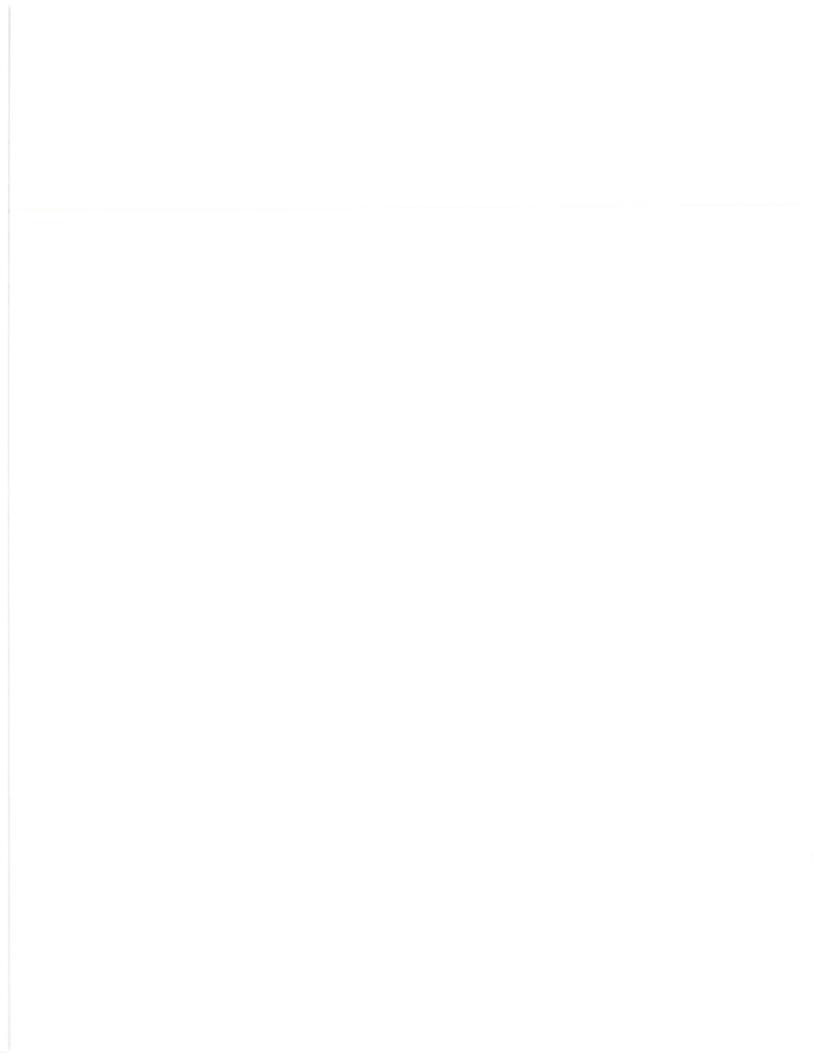

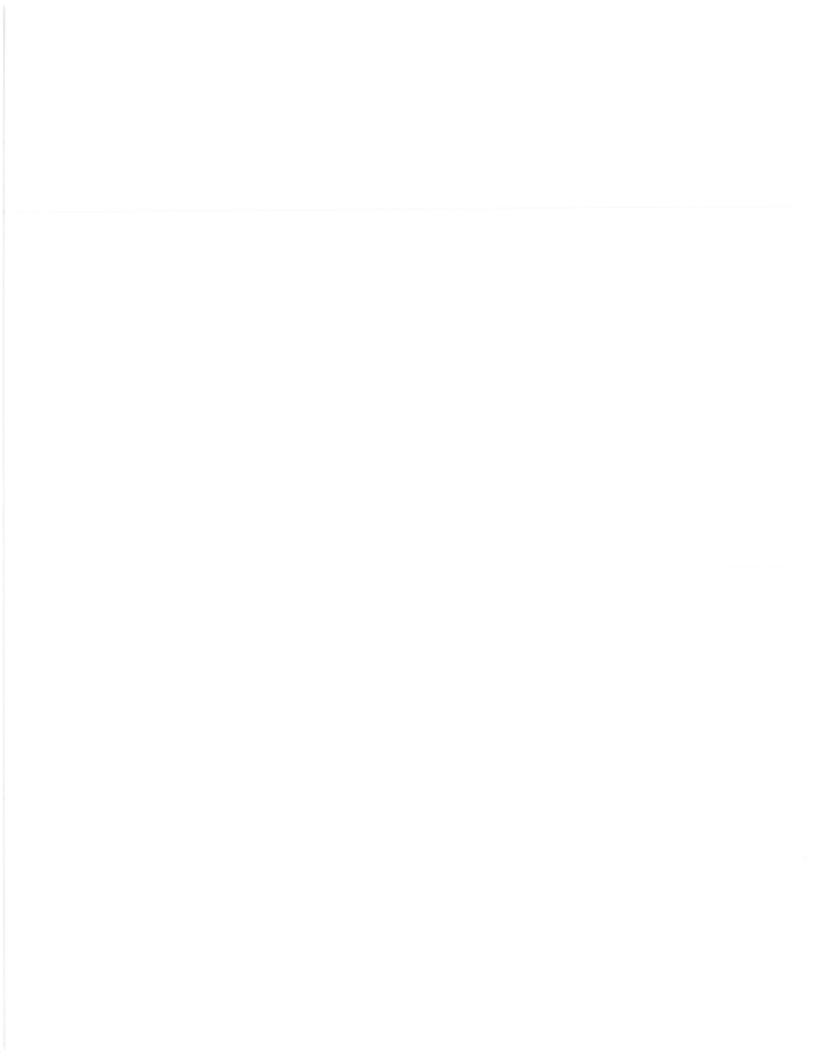
