### 2025 Church Council **Special Meeting Minutes December 4, 2025**

We had a recommendation from the Worship and Music Committee, and with the request of the Internship Committee as well to have just a single service for Vicar Natalie's last Sunday, on Feb. 22 at 9:00am, with a farewell breakfast/brunch afterward, for two reasons:

- 1) Vicar Natalie is going to be teaching the choir a piece of music that she has written for us specifically as a farewell gift, and the choir would be performing it that morning; if we had two services, she wouldn't be able to attend a breakfast in between services since she'd be practicing with the choir.
- 2) We also imagine this will be an emotional time for some, and for her, and letting that happen just in one service seems better, both for the special music and preparation and for the celebration/farewell breakfast. We are concerned that trying to shoehorn a farewell breakfast into the hour between an 8:00 and 10:00 service would rush people through, not allow time for farewells, and feel more stressful than celebratory.

#### Annual Report—Pastor's Report for 2025

There are three major areas I want to highlight at this milestone marker looking back at 2025 and looking ahead to 2026. In our congregational meeting, of course, I'll happily welcome any other questions, thoughts, or concerns on any other area of our ministry together. But here are three major pieces to start with:

#### Being a Learning Site for Vicar Natalie

Last summer in 2024, we made the commitment to agree to being a host site for a seminary intern in need of a placement in our area, and since then, we have been blessed to have Vicar Natalie among us. Throughout 2025, you have seen her grow and develop in her own gifts and pastoral presence, and you have seen her insights and voice (both spoken and sung!) making a difference in ministry life here at Community of Christ. I know many have felt blessed by her presence, and they are grateful for the new ideas, projects, events, and learnings they have benefited from because of Vicar Natalie's presence. She has been a regular presence, not only in Sunday worship in preaching and leading liturgy, but also in our weekly Bible studies and various committees and other groups. She helped us launch the summer spiritual practice series and the children's Summer Book Club and Story Hour, and she has helped put together several other special projects and activities over the course of her time here.

And as much as we feel we have been blessed by having Vicar Natalie here, I would also offer my thanks to you as a congregation for being a healthy, open, welcoming, and supportive place in which Vicar Natalie could grow and develop her own skill and pastoral identity. Having a good community in which to learn, grow, try, risk, and to be stretched is a huge part of the internship experience for seminarians, and you have been a great resource for Vicar Natalie in all of those ways. From the leadership of Pam Davis and the sounding board of the rest of the Lay Internship Committee to the people who have been regulars around the Bible study table or those who have ventured to try new spiritual practices, you have been a good and caring congregation in which Vicar Natalie could learn and be prepared for future ministry, as well as doing ministry among us now. Some future congregation somewhere will be blessed more richly because you have been a part of her formation and education, and we might never know those people's names or stories on this side of glory, but I want you to know now that you have been a blessing for her in her time here. While we will surely miss Vicar Natalie when the time comes in early 2026 for her to move on to the next steps of her formation and education, and eventually into a call to ministry in the wide world, I trust that you will continue to be a place of support and encouragement in her remaining months with us until her last Sunday on Feb. 22, 2026. Thanks to all of you for your work receiving and caring for Vicar Natalie, even as she has welcomed us into her life and offered care for this congregation!

#### New and Renewed Ministry for Children, Youth, and Family

Of course, there is another new face whom we have welcomed in this past year, and that is Bryce Hinegardner, who began serving both Community of Christ and Providence (Airport Highway) Lutheran Churches in July of 2025 in a joint role facilitating Children, Youth, and Family ministry. As you will likely recall, we had been in process seeking the right candidate from late 2023 onward, and we are grateful that Bryce has come to us. He is a major piece of the revitalization and renewal of ministries for children and youth here already. As you'll see from his report here, we have a weekly youth group shared with Providence and open to others in the community, and we are trying new ideas and activities mean to connect faith with life for kids and teenagers that you've hopefully seen already just in the half-year Bryce has been with us so far. We are excited, too, for the future and where Bryce's work will continue, grow, and develop.

I also want to note, though, that there are other pieces of children, youth, and family ministry that you have helped to blossom even prior to Bryce's starting here. And it has been exciting to see those ministries take off even prior to having a paid staff person focusing on that work. From youth activities like our car wash to benefit Neighborhood Bridges back in June to the launch of the summer reading program, with books that could be checked out and weekly story hour times, we were doing new things to include children and youth in our congregational life already. That's great, and it was great to see the parents, grandparents, and neighbors who came with kiddos to be a part of those weekly story hour times. Thanks for making that such a great experience this past summer!

When we first began the process of collaborating with Providence to share a Children Youth and Family ministry position, we reminded one another that having a staff person for this work was not a silver bullet or a magic wand to instantly create a booming youth group. We discussed at earlier congregational meetings, too, that the work of building and renewing these ministries will call for the investment of time to build relationships, to establish trust with young people, and to create our own rhythms and sense of group identity. Those things are beginning to happen, but I would invite you to continue to give this time to build and grow. Like they say, if you want crabgrass, you just have to wait a day or two—but if you want an oak tree, you have to be a little more patient. Bryce's presence, along with the dedication of parents and families here in our congregation, will help us to grow oaks rather than weeds. And again, I want to thank you as a congregation for the vision of seeing the importance of nurturing solid youth programming and faith formation here.

#### A Vision for 2026: Found Family: Claimed Together in Christ

In each of the past several years, I have offered an over-arching theme meant to frame our worship life, devotional and spiritual life, and faith formation here at Community of Christ. In 2024, our theme was **Meeting Jesus**, and in this past year of 2025, our focus has been **Life on the Edge: Christianity Beyond Our Comfort Zones**. Hopefully, over the course of the year you found those themes helpful and noticed them shaping preaching and music, artwork, and other devotional pieces of these years. In this new year, beginning with Advent

2025 and then into 2026, I'm proposing our new theme as Found Family: Claimed Together in Christ.

The idea of being a "found family" is to describe those people in your life who become your support and your safety net, even if you don't share biological or familial connections with them. Sometimes that community of people can be especially important for those who do not have a supportive family at home or are estranged from their loved ones. People sometimes talk about this new circle of love as a "found family" or a "chosen family." And in many ways, it is a compelling picture of the kind of community we are called to be as the church. We are more than a social club or collection of isolated individuals, but we are not defined by biology, ethnicity, language, or culture—we are brought into a community as authentic and dependable as family, but we have been found by Christ and gathered into it by grace, rather than by DNA.

That's the vision for our theme in 2026, which will guide preaching and teaching, shape worship, and offer direction for devotional and spiritual formation resources throughout the year ahead. We hope to focus in this coming year, starting with Advent 2025 and throughout 2026, on how God's love in Christ has gathered us into a *found family*, and how it is God's grace that has found us and made us to belong in Christ. That's the heart of the Gospel's Good News: God has found us by grace, claimed us together in Christ, and brought us into a new kind of community, not on the basis of our sameness in demographics or like-mindedness or backgrounds, but simply because God says we belong in the family. That is good news worth being reminded of, and it is worth sharing with others, too!

You'll see that focus on Sunday mornings, in my daily devotions online (at beinggraced.blogspot.com) and weekly "Looking Ahead" videos on social media, in visual arts throughout the year, and in other opportunities to learn and grow together. This coming year, our Sunday Scripture readings from the Revised Common Lectionary will be primarily rooted in Matthew's Gospel, which has a special focus on community and how we live together as "found family" in the church. We hope this time together in the Word will help deepen our connections to one another as a "found family" called Community of Christ, especially in times that can feel fragmented and harried, and that we'll be strengthened in our relationships with God and with one another through this focus.

As these areas and the rest of the reports in this packet will surely confirm, there is a lot going on at Community of Christ to be excited about—and a great deal that can grow and blossom as each of us offers to God our time, talent, and resources to bring it about. I am thankful to get to be a part of this congregation and to walk with you on the way!

#### 2025 Concert Committee Report

November 9, 2025—Amanda Worthingon Christmas Album Release Concert

And coming up still in 2025 is the December 14 concert featuring Academy Brass.

We look forward already to a Storytelling Event on January 18, 2026 featuring desserts and various storytellers, a March 15, 2026 concert featuring Tapestry (harp and guitar duo), and several other concerts and events later in the year.

We invite your voice, ideas, and hands as we try to create more opportunities to use our worship space for its supplemental purpose of being an acoustically-designed space for concerts and music. Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ! Where has the time gone? As I write this, it is hard to believe that my internship is coming to a close very soon in February. And with that realization, there is joy. This time of learning and fellowship has been fruitful and enjoyable in so many ways. It has certainly been a busy time, and it is hard to list all the things that I have done in the course of this internship. Below though is a general summary, which can give you an idea of what I have been doing during my internship:

#### Supervisor Meetings

Pastor Steve and I have met consistently on Tuesdays for our supervisor session to discuss a variety of topics. Pastor Steve has also provided sermon feedback and space for general contemplation and reflection time.

#### Internship Committee

I have met with the internship committee once a month. Pam Davis has served as the head of the internship committee through my time at Community of Christ. The internship committee also consists of Cammie Abraham, Lisa Alleman, Andrea Donley, Rebecca Jaessing, Chris Rilling, Pat Roth, and Debbie Warner. All members have been supportive during my time on internship, providing feedback on my activities during internship and offering their input and suggestions for my learning and growth.

#### Worship and Worship Leadership

I have been consistently serving in leading worship on Sunday mornings and midweek worship on occasion. When not preaching, I helped during worship lead the liturgy as needed.

#### Preaching

One of the major things I developed for the summer was a summer reading program, which allowed kids and families to check out different faith books to take home and read together. Kids received a prize when

they finished their reading cards. - Birthday postcards were sent to all active members; more than 500 cards and notes of support were sent to the homebound, those on the prayer list, and others.
- 549 freezer meals were prepared for those needing a hot meal without worry.
- 36 prayer shawls and several baptismal blankets were handmade and shared.
- 19 college students received cookie boxes and other notes and cards during their school year.
- Monthly visits were made to Blue Creek Care Center, and more than 140 handmade Christmas ornaments will be shared with their residents and others.
- Spring & Fall Cookie Sundays—Worshippers enjoyed a cookie after service and then shared
   125 bags with those in the community.
- 25 Easter baskets were filled and shared with homebound members and others.
- Increased use was made of "Need a ride?"
- 6 gatherings of "Conversation & More..." were held, beginning with a luncheon in September.

- Continue the activities already in place.
- Find additional ways to help Blue Creek, including regular visits from Hazel, the therapy
- Continue our Educational Focus on End-of-Life decisions with a March workshop.
- Expand contact with our military service people during the year.

#### Highlights:

- Evaluated the option to repair or replace the HVAC unit in the church office due to a failed heat exchanger. The HVAC unit was replaced in February.
- Wayne King presented a need to the congregation for lawn trimming assistance and coordinated the volunteers.
- A leaky urinal valve has been repaired.
- Jerry Jones has cut a piece of soffit to replace the rotted piece at the north entrance to the church (installed on June 16).
- Sidewalk leveling project (obtained quotes and made recommendation to council completed in April).
- Dan Sigg changed out the filters in the HVAC system.
- The property committee hosted "mulch" day on May 10th. We had 11 volunteers show up to add a fresh layer of mulch to the landscaping.
- Evaluated an LED solution for the sanctuary ceiling lights. It is becoming difficult to find replacement ballasts for the existing dimmable fluorescents fixtures.

#### **Notable Accomplishments:**

An addition to the Prairie Meadow was planned which will double its size to .5 acre. The area was plotted out in the spring to achieve a more aesthetically pleasing curved front edge. The addition was herbicided numerous times this summer and tilled twice. Seeding of the addition is planned for early winter 2027, which will allow for a full year of "killing and tilling" so that the weed seed bank, especially of cold germinating weeds such as clover, can be better exhausted prior to seeding.

The original Prairie Meadow plot was planted with over 200 plugs of 4 native species in the area where white clover has dominated. The Prairie Meadow bloomed extremely well for a second-year plot with more than 30 native species blooming throughout the season.

The Prairie Meadow was included in the summer Spiritual Practices series for an Introduction to Forest Bathing. A short path was mowed in the plot to accommodate access to the inside of the plot.

## **Goals and Objectives for Upcoming Year**

**Goals:** Promote use of the Prairie Meadow for meditation, stewardship, education, and appreciation of creation.

Objectives: 1. Continue work on expansion of the Prairie Meadow to .5 acre

- Salem Lutheran Our congregation has 3 volunteers preparing 250-300 take home meals monthly. We also raised \$1000 to purchase and plant 6 trees on the church property, and \$751 for Salem Food Ministry.
- Collecting for multiple food banks We recently sent food to the food shelves at the 180<sup>th</sup> Fighter
  Wing, Ohio Air National Guard. In addition, we collected food and money for Salem Lutheran, Local
  Foodbanks, and backpacks for the weekend. For God's Work Our Hands, we made over 200 peanut
  sandwiches and donated replacement ingredients for the next group of volunteers. These sandwiches
  were distributed through Food for Thought, in downtown Toledo, on Saturday morning. Food for
  Thought distributes them every Saturday of the year, without exception.
- Two Christmas activities We collected gifts for the Angel Tree for Salem and also participated for gifts for the Luther Home of Mercy Adopt-a-Resident Program

- We welcomed the representative from Isaiah 117. This a long-term project building a house that will
  enable children in Northwest Ohio to have a home environment when they get brought into the foster

Greetings in the name of Christ! It has been my pleasure to come alongside Community of Christ and Providence over the past four months as we begin this partnered ministry to help the children, youth, and families of both congregations become and make disciples of Jesus. In this short time, we've launched new programs, revitalized existing ones, and started dreaming about what's next. Below is a summary of what we've accomplished and where we're headed.

#### Youth Group

Our joint youth group is off to an excellent start! With regular attendance of about a dozen youth in grades 6–12, we've spent time discerning what it means to be a youth group and what the youth themselves hope to gain from the experience. We've already completed service projects, participated in fellowship events, and helped lead a worship service. The enthusiasm and engagement from the youth have been incredibly encouraging.

#### **Sunday School**

Thanks to last year's teachers and several new volunteers, we have been able to offer Sunday School each week for two age groups since September 14. This fall we launched a new digital curriculum, Wonder Ink, which walks through the biblical narrative from beginning to end each year while exploring major themes and stories. The children have responded well to the format and content.

#### Confirmation

I have had the privilege of participating in and helping to lead Confirmation alongside Pastor Steve, Vicar Natalie, and the leaders from Zion Lutheran. This collaboration has offered a meaningful way to get to know the youth from both congregations and to invite them more fully into our youth group community.

#### **Anthony Wayne Area Youth**

Originally founded by four Anthony Wayne—area churches, this group now includes Providence Lutheran as well. Our focus is to host quarterly events that bring youth from across the area together for fun, fellowship, and invite them to our faith-forming ministries.

#### **Preaching**

I was honored to share the message during our youth-led Thanksgiving service. It was a blessing to work with our youth in planning and participating in that worship experience.

#### What's to Come

In the coming year, my goal is to continue refining and strengthening programs that help our children, youth, and families grow in their relationship with Christ. Our youth group will follow the church's yearly theme of "Found Family," exploring how we—as a youth group, as students, and as disciples—can create spaces of belonging and spiritual family rooted in God's love.
